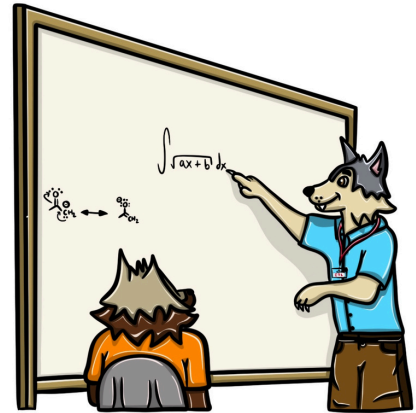

Speaker: Tara Palomares

Tara Palomares, doctoral student in the Teaching, Learning, and Teacher Education Program at UNM. Palomares is the recipient of the Presidential Award for Excellence in Mathematics and Science Teaching (PAEMST). Palomares holds a B.S. in mathematics and an M.A. in education from Stanford University, and has been teaching mathematics for 12 years, the last eight at Sandia HS.

A National Board-Certified Teacher, Palomares facilitates several professional development groups at her school and is a mentor for teachers pursuing National Board Certification. Palomares also received the Woodrow Wilson Leonore Annenberg Teaching Fellowship and is a Senior Fellow at the Knowles Teacher Initiative.
